What is Document L ?

This is part of the building regulations for England and Wales that sets the levels of energy efficiency in buildings, this now covers replacement windows. A thermal U-value of 2.0W/m² must be achieved for windows and doors

Our products have had the Hot Box tested at the BBA, test report no. 1759 to assess the product efficiencies. We achieved U-values lower than the required standard (the lower a products U-value the more thermally efficient the product becomes). Our systems achieved a U-value of 1.76 W/m² - considerably lower than the required 2.0 W/m² under the new regulations

Glass Units

Sealed units must now comply with EN1279 (which replaces BS5713). All our Document L compliant units are **Pilkington K Glass** or above (*to learn more about Pilkington K Glass see our leaflet*)

Building Regulations

Document L results in all replacement windows and doors requiring either planning permission or installation by a member of FENSA. The responsibility of ensuing replacement windows are installed to these new requirements rests with the installer.

However when you come to sell you home, not having your windows fitted by a FENSA installer could reduce the value of your home
